



## **Information Sheet Business and Professions Code Section 19094**

If your flammability label is marked “contain NO Flame retardant chemicals”, you are declaring that flame retardant chemicals are not present in any component of your covered product at levels above 1,000 parts per million (ppm).<sup>1</sup>

Component is defined as “the separate constituent parts of upholstered furniture sold in California, as identified in Technical Bulletin 117-2013, specifically cover fabrics, barrier materials, resilient filling materials, and decking materials.”<sup>2</sup>

If the Bureau requests documentation to support your flammability label's claim, you may provide a written statement from the supplier of each component stating that flame retardant chemicals were not added to those components.<sup>3</sup> You must submit this documentation within 30 days of the Bureau's initial request.
